Subject:- Grant of Conditional Permission with seat reduction to Shri Satya Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Dhanupura (Lodhipur Rajput) Delhi Road, Post Pakbara, Moradabad-244102, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID. AYU0498) for 48 seats after seat reduction in intake capacity of 60 seats as per your request vide ref. no. SSAMCH/23/48 dated 06.09.2023 for issuance of permission for 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course instead of 100 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24 and relevant regulations thereunder-reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under.

Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **to Shri Satya Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Dhanupura (Lodhipur Rajput) Delhi Road, Post Pakbara, Moradabad-244102, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID. AYU0498)** inspection of your College was conducted on **18.05.2023 and 19.05.2023 on hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, NCISM to process **the Conditional permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under Section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 for the academic session 2023-24.**
2. Further in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. **On examining the same certain deficiencies were observed by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM).**
3. Furthermore, 17 teaching staff namely 1) Dr. Sai Chandrakant Kolte, 2) Dr. Pethe Anand Sambhaji, 3) Dr. Saorabh Kumar, 4) Dr. K V Nageswara Rao, 5) Dr. Kuntal Milind Walunjkar, 6) Dr. Amol P Patinge, 7) Dr. Nilima Liladhar Bhole, 8) Dr. Virendra Kumar shrivastava, 9) Dr. Rekha Sharma, 10) Dr. Kapil Kumar Sharma, 11) Dr. Laxman Maruti Wandekar, 12) Dr. Vinay Sharma, 13) Dr. Abdul Kareem H, 14) Dr. Balraj Singh, 15) Dr. Jyothi M Giradkar, 16) Dr. Kiran Arvind Patange, 17) Dr. Ravinder Sharma, found to be working only on paper and hence not considered as regular teachers in the college and same was informed to you vide ref no. Teacher Verification/MARB/2023 dated 23.08.2023 and after excluding the above mentioned on paper teachers it was found that the college is **not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for grant of Conditional permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2023-24**
4. As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the **54th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **22.08.2023**. On careful examination of the assessment report it was found that **your college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria for issuance of Conditional permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2023-24**

5. Further in response to the letter vide ref no. Teacher Verification/MARB/2023 dated 23.08.2023, your college has submitted a request letter vide ref no. SSAMCH/12 dated 31.08.2023 regarding the payment of imposed monetary penalty of Rs. 4.25 crores in 09 installments and to consider for the issuance of permission with 60 seats instead of 100 seats vide ref no. SSAMCH/23/48 for the academic session 2023-24 to your college on the condition that your college should pay the penalty amount of Rs.4.50 crores in 09 installments. The 1st installment of Rs.50 Lakhs shall be paid immediately and remaining 08 installments shall be paid within 08 months of 1st installment or before issuance of permission for the academic session 2024-25 whichever is earlier. After payment of first installment permission for the academic session 2023-24 shall be consider as per rules.
6. Further as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the **57th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held **on 05.09.2023** and the board discussed and decided to accept the request and to re-assess the College in terms of enforced regulation namely the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under.
7. Thereafter, on further Scrutiny of your College's assessment report, it was observed that, your college is **not fulfilling the criteria for issuance of Conditional permission with 60 seats (instead of 100 seats) in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 for the academic Session 2023-24, due to the deficiency in the number of eligible teaching faculty after reducing the on paper faculties.**
 - a) Therefore, it is observed that there is a deficiency of one higher faculty each in the department of (i) Swasthavritta & Yoga, (ii) Kaumarbhritya – BalaRoga, (iii) Shalakya Tantra, (iv) Panchkarma & (v) Rachana Sharir. Hence, the availability of total teaching staff for 60 seats in UG is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100 = \frac{25}{30} \times 100 = 83.33\%$.
8. Further the same was communicated to your College vide Ref even no. dated 05.09.2023, in response you have furnished the imposed penalty amount worth **Rupees 50 lakh** in favour of The national Commission fund for Indian System of Medicine through **RTGS Vide UTR No. UBINH23249287233 dated 06.09.2023**
9. **In view of the above, the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), decided to grant you the Conditional Permission as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the Academic year 2023-24, wherein it is mentioned that:-**

"For deficiency of **every one teacher**, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 10 % of total intake capacity."
10. **Therefore, in accordance of seat reduction policy 2023-2024, for deficiency of every one teacher, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 10% of total intake capacity. Hence, after applying the seat reduction policy 2023-24, the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) decided to issue the Conditional permission with 48 seats (instead of 60 seats) in UG (BAMS) Course under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 for the academic Session 2023-24.**
11. Therefore, **Conditional Permission with seat reduction to Shri Satya Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital, Dhanupura (Lodhipur Rajput) Delhi Road, Post Pakbara, Moradabad-244102, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID. AYU0498) for 48 seats after seat reduction in intake capacity of 60 seats as per your request vide ref. no. SSAMCH/23/48 dated 06.09.2023 for issuance of permission for 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course instead of 100 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following requirements: -**
 - I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - II. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of **48 seats instead of 60 seats** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
 - III. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no.BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
12. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
13. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued**

• permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or subsequent year.

14. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
15. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2024-2025:-
- all the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
 - all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto; and
16. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.
